### NEW BUSINESS

Several members discussed that it was a successful venture in the past and concurred that SOS will again conduct a pizza sale. Ms. Matheny stated she would talk to LaRosa's about the timing of the deliveries of the pizzas. Ms. Hocter suggested personal pan pizza sizes as well. ### TREASURER'S REPORT

Ms. Matheny provided the SOS Income Statement. In the General Fund, there was an ending balance of \$7,285.92; the no expenditures the past month. In the Christmas fund, there is a balance of \$2,953.78. Ms. Matheny reported that she has received monthly donations from Mr. Bailey and a quarterly donation from Mrs. McNear; however, she wanted to get SOS input as to which fund the money should go into. The decision was made that the donations would go into the Christmas Fund.


### DISCUSSION
