

Part-Time Parks Maintenance Worker

The City of Springdale Parks and Recreation Department is accepting applications for the position of Part-Time Parks Maintenance Worker. Parks Maintenance Workers are responsible for performing semi-skilled maintenance tasks such as grass cutting; laying out, maintaining, and repairing athletic fields and courts; snow removal; and a variety of other tasks required to support the Parks and Recreation Department.

Candidates for the position must:

- Be at least 18 years of age at time of appointment and eligible for employment in the U.S.
- Have earned a high school diploma or G.E.D. equivalent at time of appointment.
- Possess a valid driver's license.
- Have knowledge of and experience with facility/grounds maintenance and equipment, tools, and materials.
- Have the ability and willingness to perform heavy physical labor for extended periods of time under all weather conditions.
- Obtain a valid Class A or B Commercial driver's License within 6 months of hire date.

The starting pay for this position is \$13.80.
