



## RECREATION PROGRAMMER

The City of Springdale Parks & Recreation Department is accepting applications and resumes for the position of Recreation Programmer. This full-time position provides oversight and direction for the community's recreational sports, classes, activities, and special events for preschoolers through adults. Candidates for the position must:

- Be at least eighteen (18) years of age and eligible for employment in the U.S.
- Possess an Associate's Degree in Parks & Recreation or a closely related field; a Bachelor's Degree in Parks & Recreation or equivalent experience is preferred
- Have a minimum of two (2) years supervisory experience with four (4) years progressively responsible experience in Parks & Recreation or a related field
- Have excellent administrative, organizational, customer service, leadership, and communication skills
- Have ability to work a varied schedule to include extended hours, evenings, weekends, holidays, and emergency call-outs
- Previous experience in sports programming and Rec Trac software is preferred

The annual salary range for this position is \$53,469.70 to \$83,412.73 with a comprehensive benefits package and state pension.
