OUR ORGANIZATION

The Springdale Board of Health is the policy-making body of the department and consists of 5 members appointed by the Mayor and approved by the City Council. The members are appointed for staggered 2-year terms and meet on the second Thursday of each month in the Municipal Building. The Board appoints the Health Commissioner who, along with the staff, enforces the rules and regulations of the State of Ohio and the Board of Health and carries out the programs designed to meet your needs.

EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS PLANNING

As part of the Springdale Health Department's public health emergency preparedness efforts, response plans have been developed, exercised and are updated annually. The Springdale Health Department is part of a regional public health network in southwest Ohio that partners with other local public health departments, hospitals, the Ohio Department of Health, local EMA and local first responders to plan and prepare for emergencies.
